

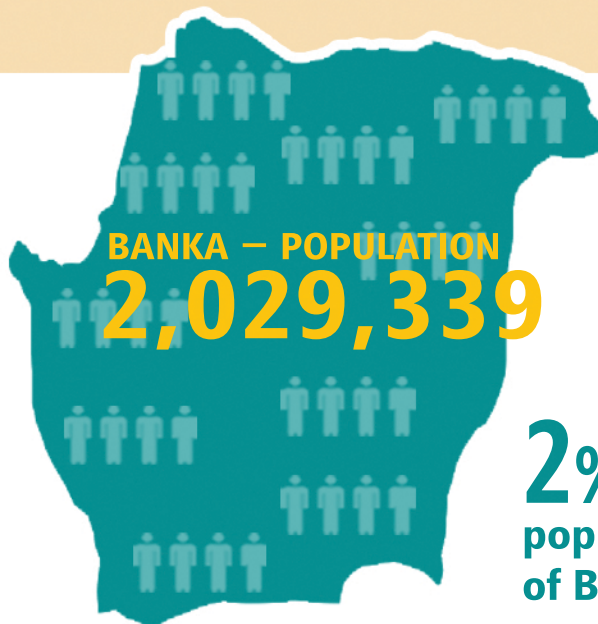
# BANKA

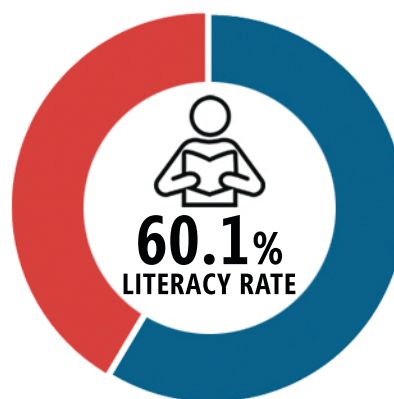

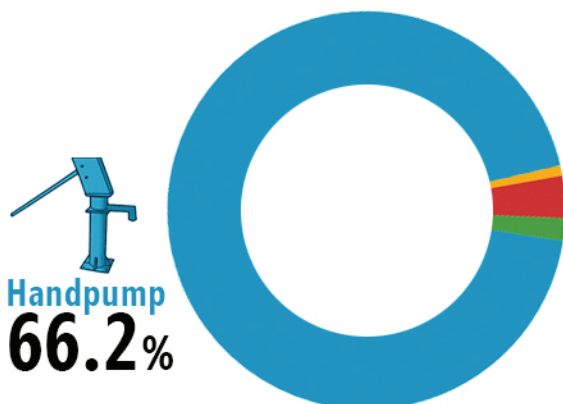
