

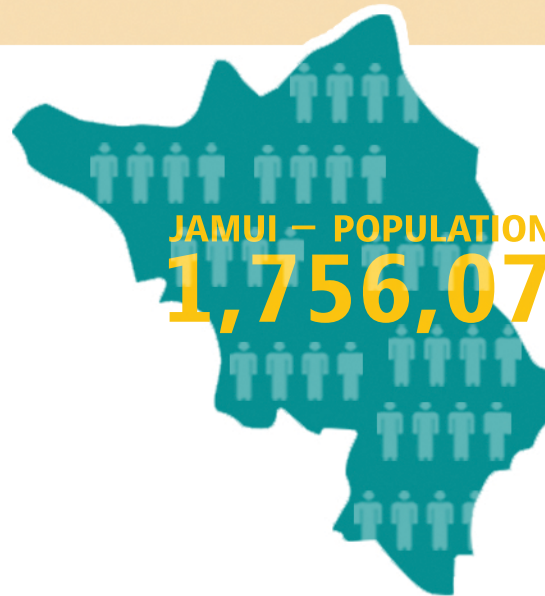
JAMUI

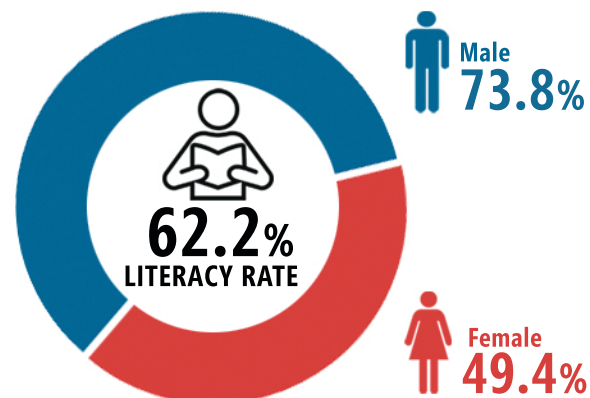

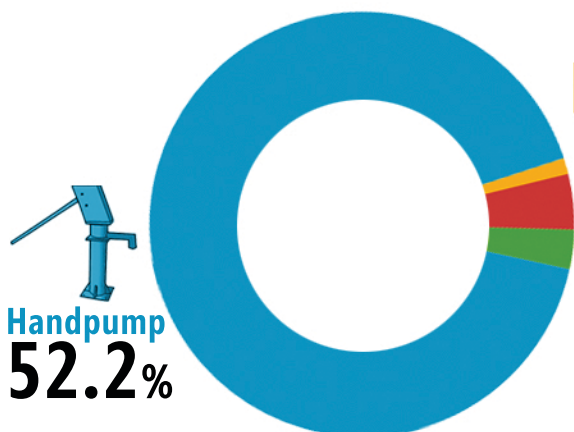
