

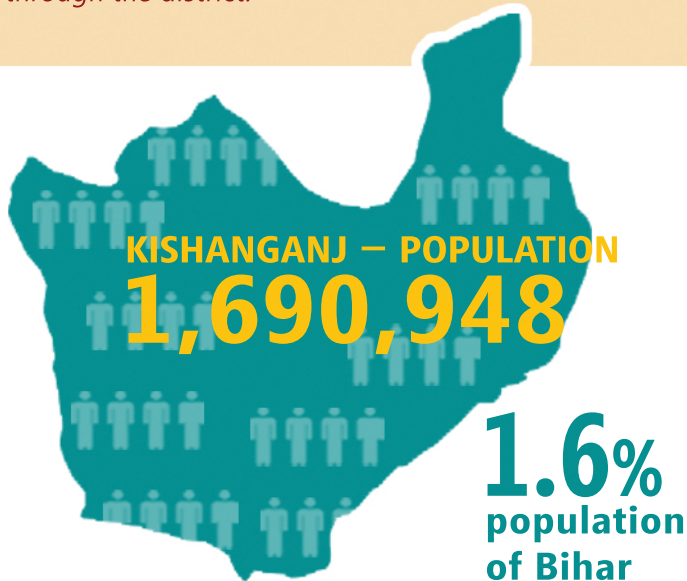
# KISHANGANJ

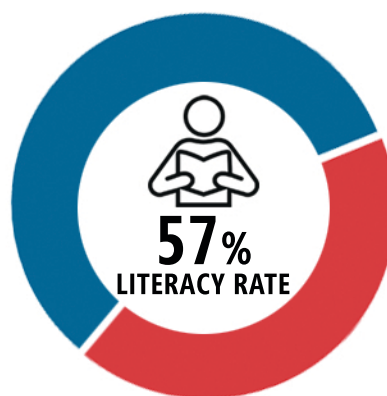

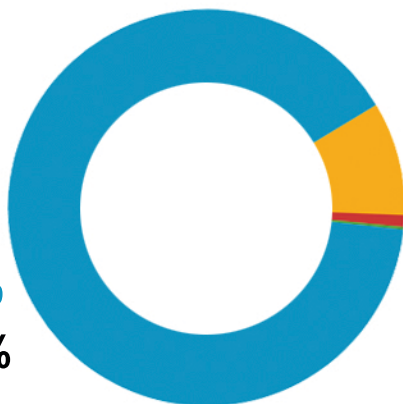
