

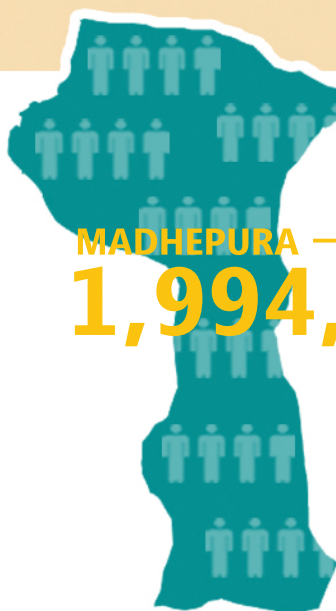
# MADHEPURA

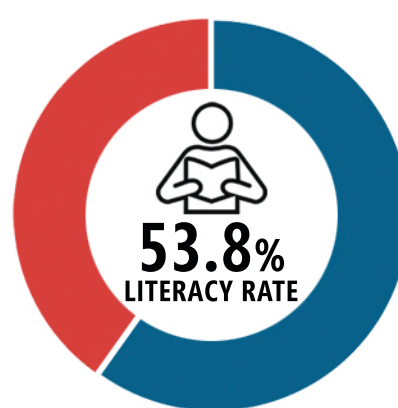
