

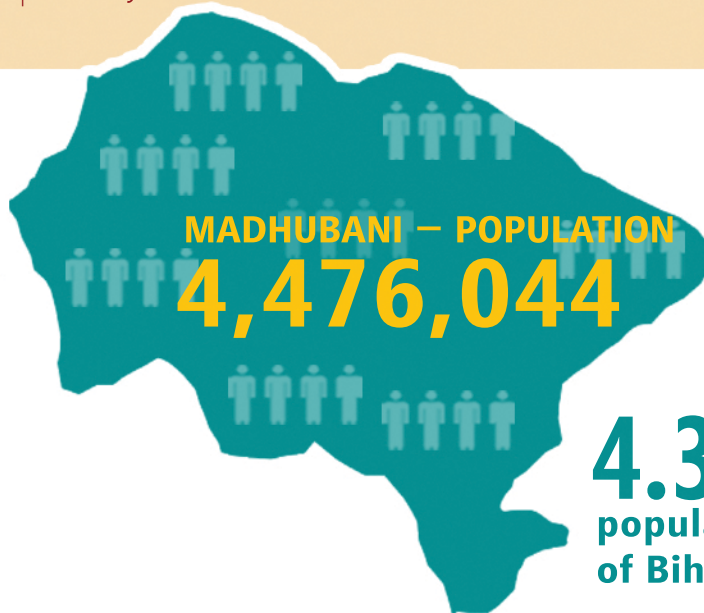
MADHUBANI

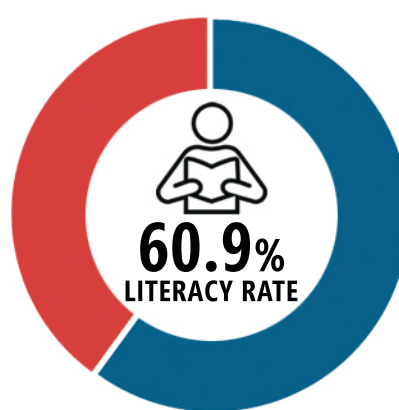

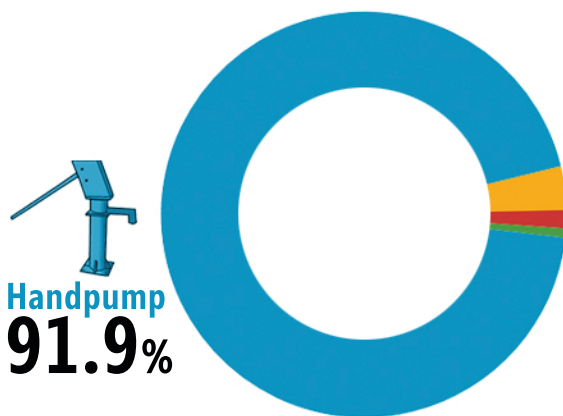
