

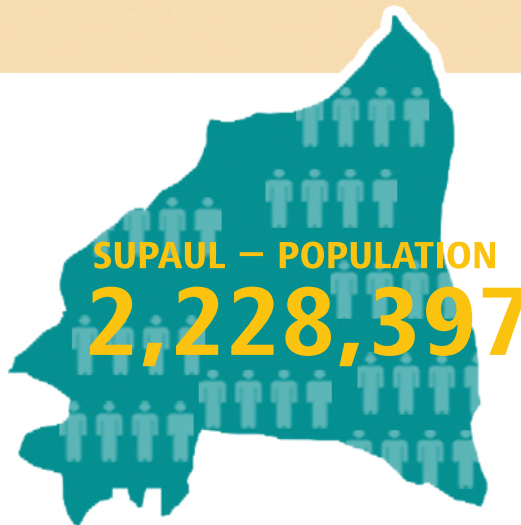
# SUPAUL

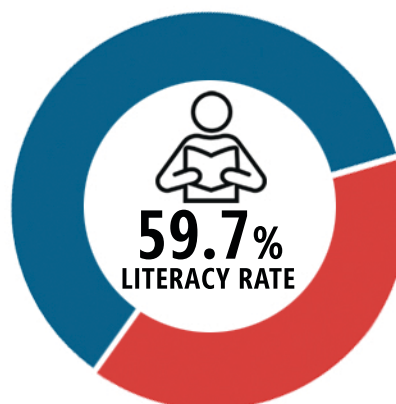

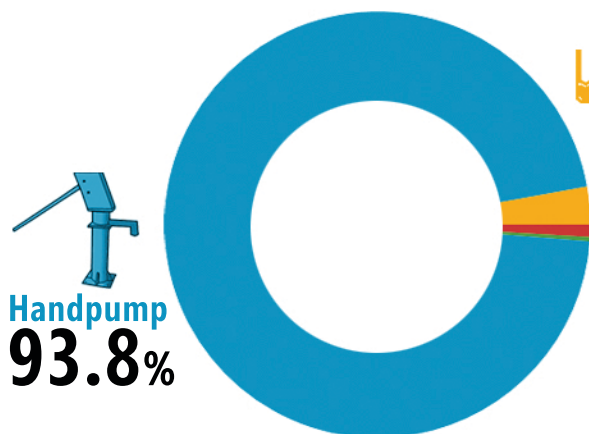
